Current Activities and Recent Accomplishments

1. <u>i-B Governing Board meetings</u>

Two conference calls were held to conduct i-B Governing Board meetings on August 22 and September 15. President Megha Parajulee, President-Elect Maya Evenden, Past-President Margaret Hardy, Governing Board Representative Livy Williams, Secretary Rory McDonnell, and ESA's Program & Meetings Manager Becky Anthony were in attendance and/or sent their input to the Board. These meetings largely focused on planning for a Virtual Symposium where Branch members can participate in scientific symposium. Branch annual Business Meeting would still be conducted at the ESA Annual meeting.

3. Virtual Symposium

The first ever International Branch Virtual Symposium has been planned for April 16-18, 2018. This new event will feature three days of video and virtual poster presentations focused on three primary topic areas: Integrated Pest Management, Invasive Species, and Science Communication. The International Branch leadership is currently developing a quality, interactive program to engage International Branch members around the globe. Confex web submission for virtual poster presentations will be opened on November 7, 2017 with the submission deadline of February 5, 2018. Registration for the symposium will open December 15, 2017.

The Board decided to charge US\$25 per virtual poster submission. This fee is expected to cover the Confex charge of conducting the virtual symposium. The Board decided to keep the symposium fee low to launch the Program and then evaluate the success of the first symposium before we use virtual symposium as a source of income generation for the Branch. The submission fee also covers the registration fees for the presenting author of the virtual poster. Non-presenters can register for the symposium at \$25 registration fee.

4. i-B Awards

The International Branch selected two awardees to be recognized at ESA annual meeting in Denver: Isobel Ronai (Comstock Award) and Antonio Panizzi (IB

Distinguished Scientist Award). Although the Branch has two other awards, Early Career Research and Leadership Award and Graduate Student Award, no awardees were selected for these awards this year.
