# **Business:**

- Updates from Entomology 2023:
  - Awards
    - Opportunities for updating/changing current awards. A lot of the awards aren't getting nominations or being given on an annual basis.
       Modifications could include changing the frequency of awards to every other year.
    - Peat Management Team awards may have an increase in applicants by switching to every other year or every three since team building takes time. Funding may also be changing to every other year, and it would be PIE responsibility to cover cost in off year if we decide to not change the award frequency.
    - ESA would do their part to make it clear when the award is being offered and would encourage nominations during those years assuming the switch was made to offer the award every two or three years. Also need to work on marketing award nominations.
    - Anjel moved to make to offer the IPM team award during odd years.
       Surendra seconded the motion. All were in favor and the motion was approved.
  - o Considerations of opportunities other ESA sections are currently implementing.
    - Graduate student travel award opportunity.
      - Most sections are currently providing travel grants for graduate students. This tends to have strong application numbers. Need to find a balance between unrepresented group and others in need.
      - Applicants can be low in some years so awards aren't given annually depending on the applicant pool. Should PI and departments be involved in the applicant process.
      - Dollar amount varies between sections. Only out of pocket expenses for reimbursement are food and beverage.
      - In addition to covering travel expenses, consideration of adding a monetary award to encourage applicants.
      - Increasing applicants before adding additional awards should be the top priority.
      - Ways for promotion: increase announcements at branch meetings or sending personal emails vs newsletter. ESA can work with us

on branding to have emails look more personal. Message from the PIE President with a picture. Can also target new student message that have a high open rate.

Topic was tabled for future discussion.
