Personal information is only used to deliver a frictionless and secure experience with CLEAR and Entomology 2021. DON'T HAVE A SMARTPHONE? For attendees who do not have a smartphone or do not wish to download the CLEAR app, please enter the CCC through the doors closest to the Hyatt Regency Denver. You'll be directed to our onsite Safety and Wellness Desk to check-in. Please bring your vaccination card or a copy of your recent negative COVID-19 test.

DIDN'T TEST IN ADVANCE? A limited number of onsite rapid tests will be available for attendees who are not vaccinated and did not arrive with PCR test results. An onsite EMT will provide a complimentary, self-administered rapid test. Upon receiving a negative result, you will be directed on how to complete your health survey each day to receive a Health Pass to enter the event. You may be asked to test again when entering the convention center in the future. If you test positive onsite, you will be denied entry into the CCC and directed to the Denver Health Urgent Care located at 1545 California St. for a PCR test. While waiting for your PCR testing results, we require that you quarantine from other Entomology 2021 attendees. ESA will follow up with you and your host hotel regarding your quarantine. FOR THIS REASON - WE RECOMMEND TESTING IN ADVANCE BEFORE TRAVELING TO DENVER.

About Posters

Poster Setup

Your poster must be placed in the assigned numbered space in the Exhibit Hall the night before your poster is scheduled (see "Poster Presentation Times" for additional information). Bring your own Velcro strips to secure your display to the poster board. The poster board is covered with felt cloth and the frame is aluminum. Please do not attach anything to the metal frame.

Presenters are expected to be available at their displays during the "Authors Present" time slot for questions and discussion.
